1. Add MUFU to Wallet

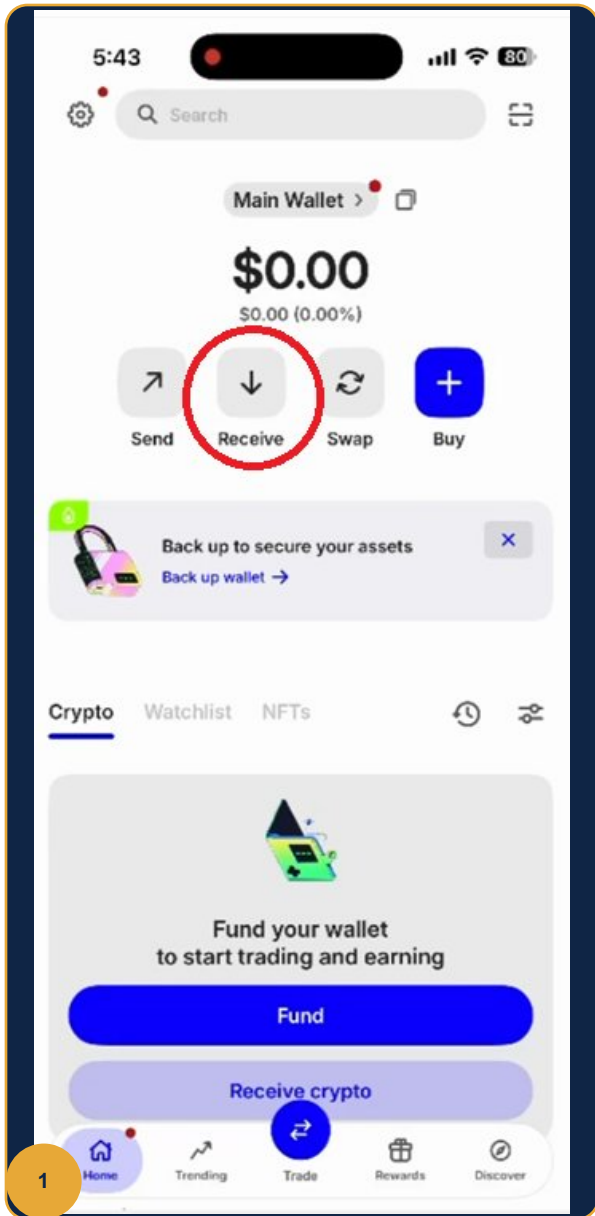
3. Swap BNB for MUFU

iPhone: 2 steps | Android: 3 steps

Security warning: Only ever add MUFU using the contract address shown above, verified at mufutoken.com. Scammers create fake tokens with similar names. Never trust addresses shared via social media, DMs, or third-party websites. Always verify on BscScan.

iPHONE — 1. Add MUFU to Wallet

Follow these 7 steps to add MUFU to Trust Wallet on your iPhone. Contract address:
0xAACDd8EA3F1893d01f9DA413C0a593fb39B970B9

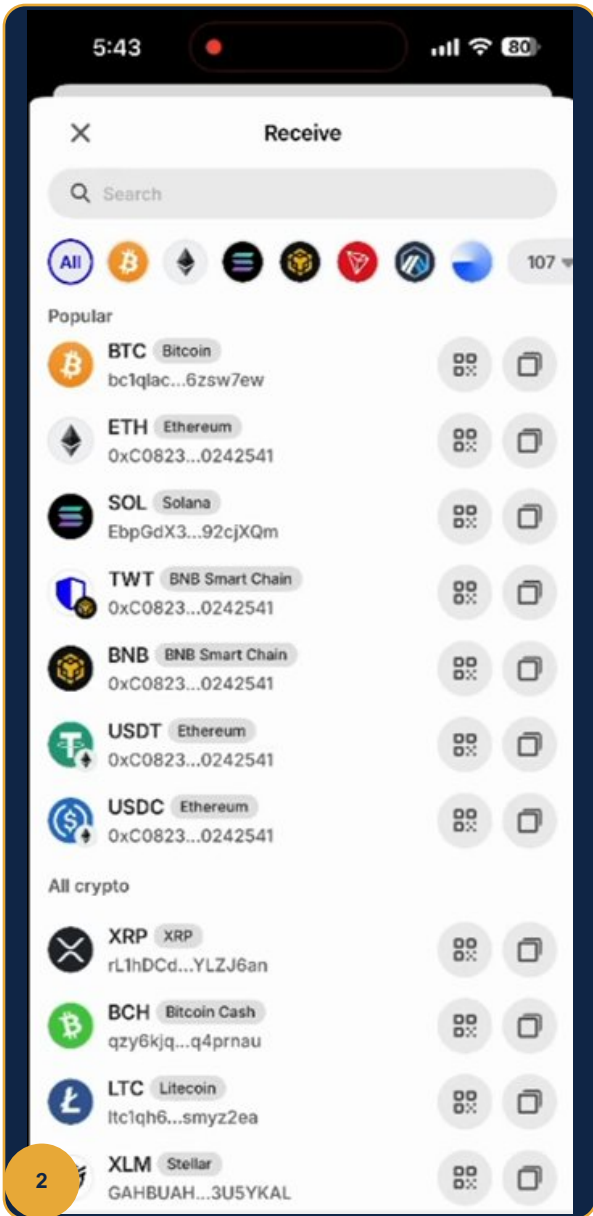


STEP 1 OF 7

Open Trust Wallet and tap Receive

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Receive button — the downward arrow — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure Trust Wallet is installed from the App Store.



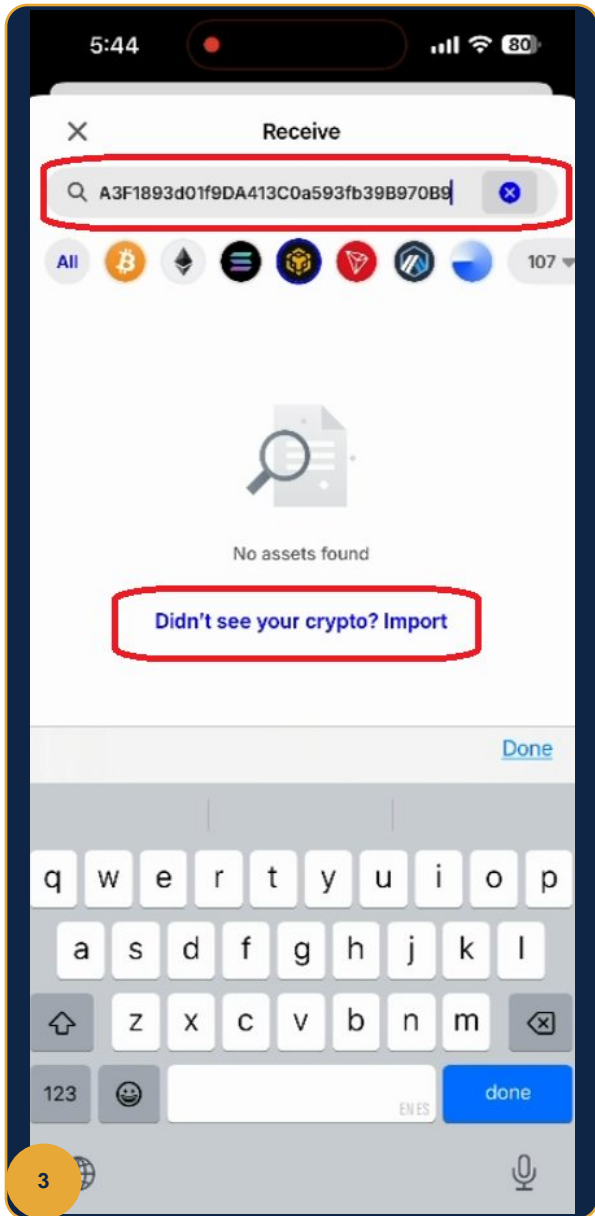
STEP 2 OF 7

Copy the CA, then paste into Search

Copy the MUFU contract address:

0xAAACDd8EA3F1893d01f9DA413C0a593fb39B970B9 — then paste it into the Receive search bar. MUFU will not appear automatically.

Tip: Always copy — never type. A single wrong character will cause the import to fail.

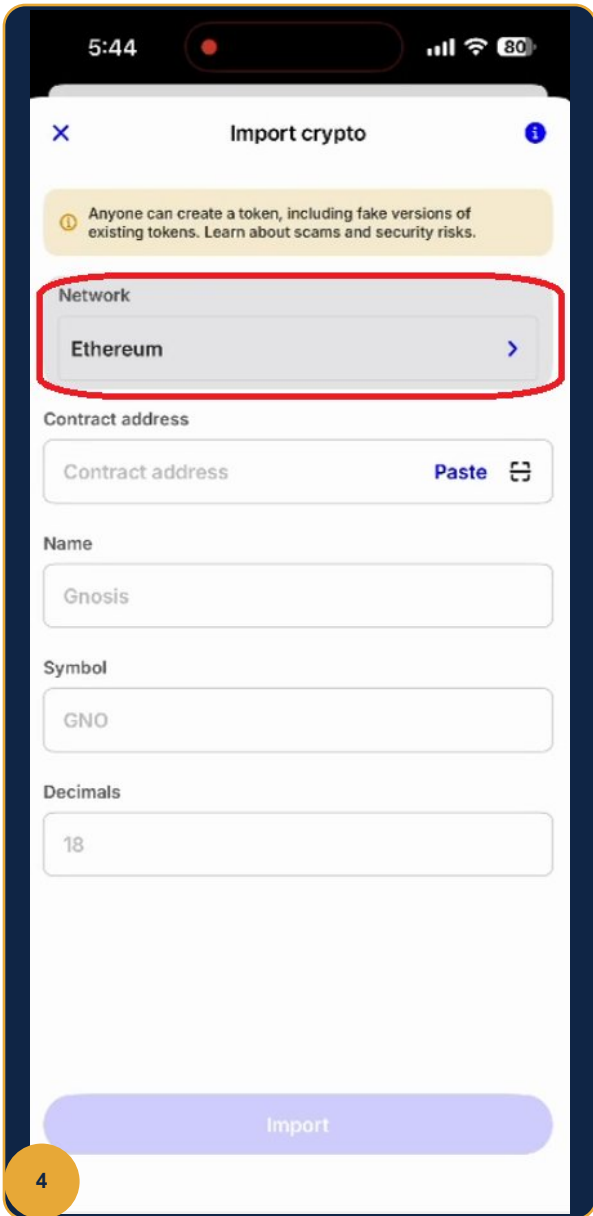


STEP 3 OF 7

Tap "Didn't see your crypto? Import"

When the search returns no results, tap the Import link at the bottom of the screen.

Tip: This link only appears after a search — make sure the full contract address is pasted first.

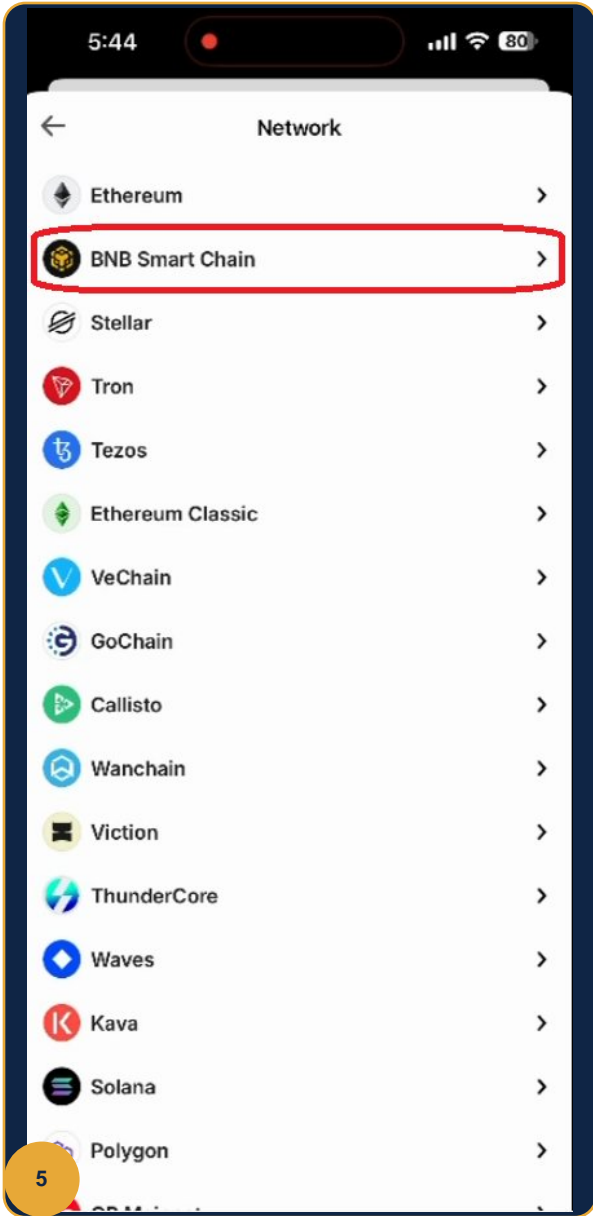


STEP 4 OF 7

Change the network to BNB Smart Chain

The Import crypto screen opens with Ethereum pre-selected. Tap the Network field and choose BNB Smart Chain.

Note: Critical: selecting Ethereum instead of BNB Smart Chain will cause the import to fail.

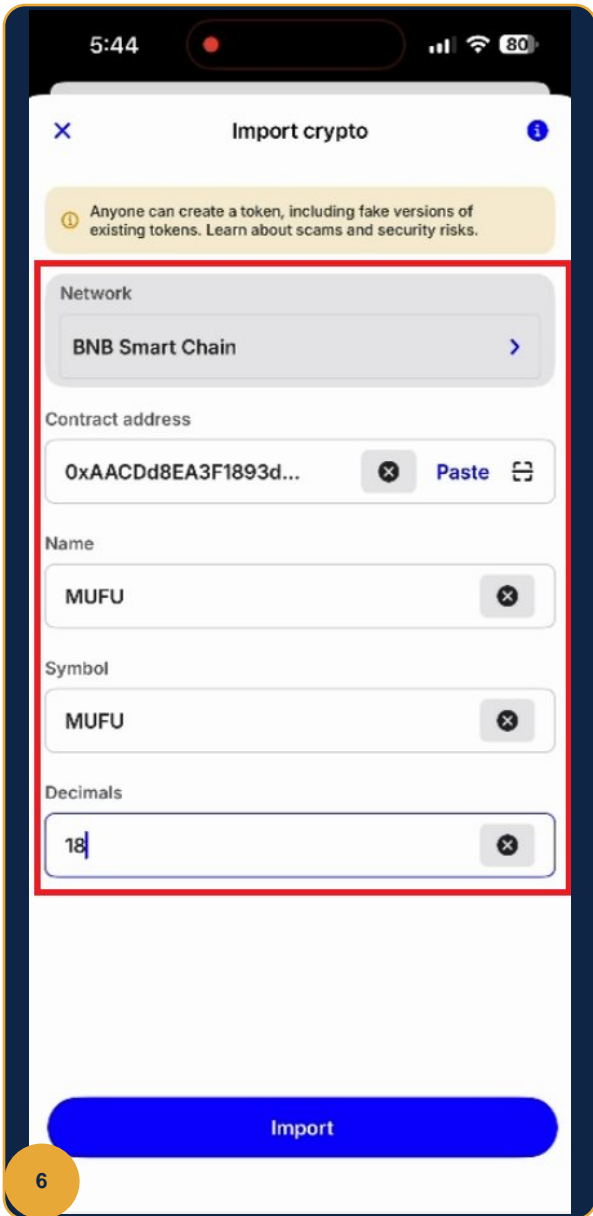


STEP 5 OF 7

Select BNB Smart Chain from the list

On the Network selection screen, scroll down and tap BNB Smart Chain. MUFU is a BEP-20 token and only works on this network.

Tip: BNB Smart Chain appears near the top of the list.

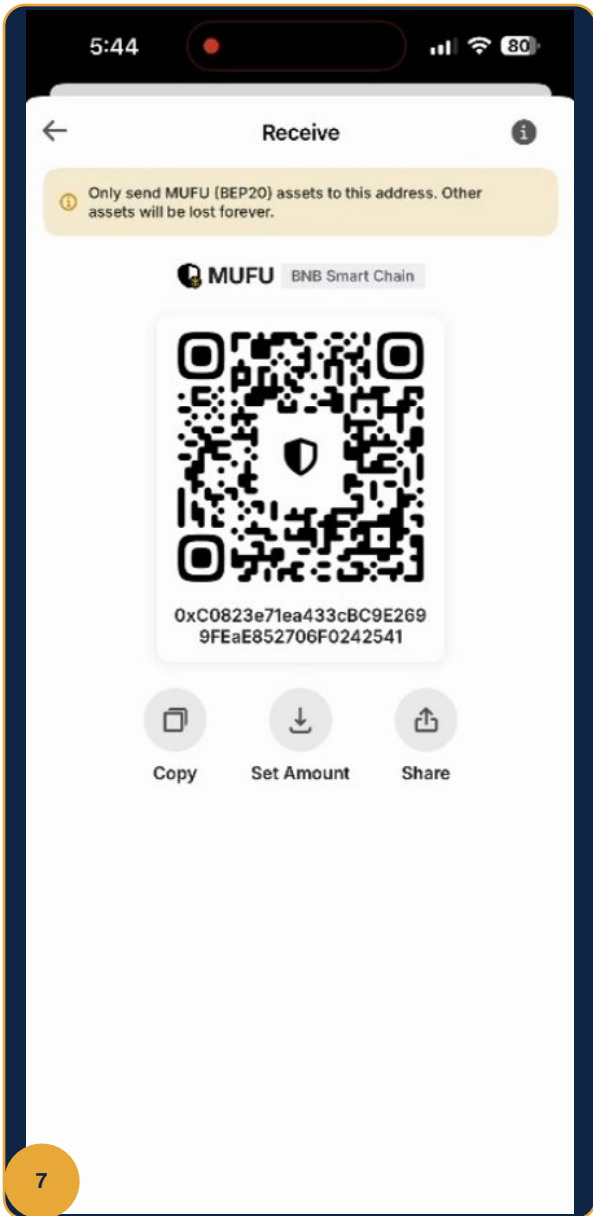


STEP 6 OF 7

Enter token details and tap Import

Paste the contract address in the Address field. Fields may auto-fill — if they do not, enter manually: Name = MUFU, Symbol = MUFU, Decimals = 18. Tap Import.

Note: Decimals must be 18. If any field stays blank, double-check the network is BNB Smart Chain.



STEP 7 OF 7

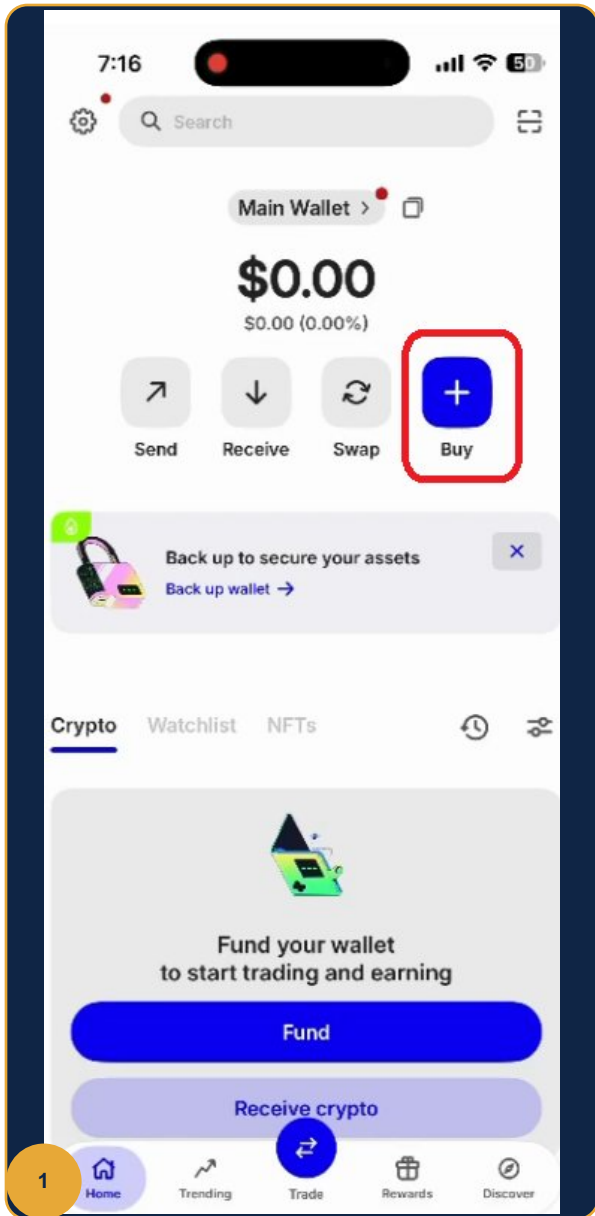
Copy or share your MUFU receive address

Your MUFU receive screen shows your QR code and full wallet address. Use Copy, Set Amount, or Share to provide your address.

Note: Only send MUFU (BEP-20) to this address. Sending any other token type will result in permanent loss of funds.

iPHONE — 2. Buy BNB

Follow these 6 steps to purchase BNB in Trust Wallet on your iPhone.

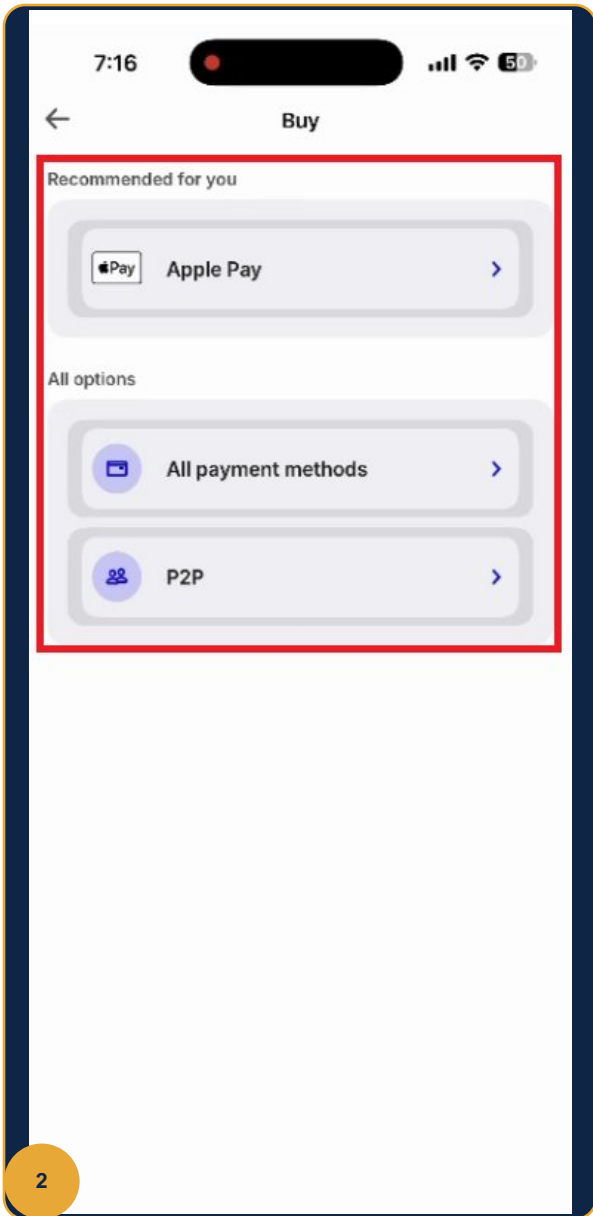


STEP 1 OF 6

Open Trust Wallet and tap Buy

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Buy button — the blue + icon — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure Trust Wallet is installed from the App Store and your wallet is set up.

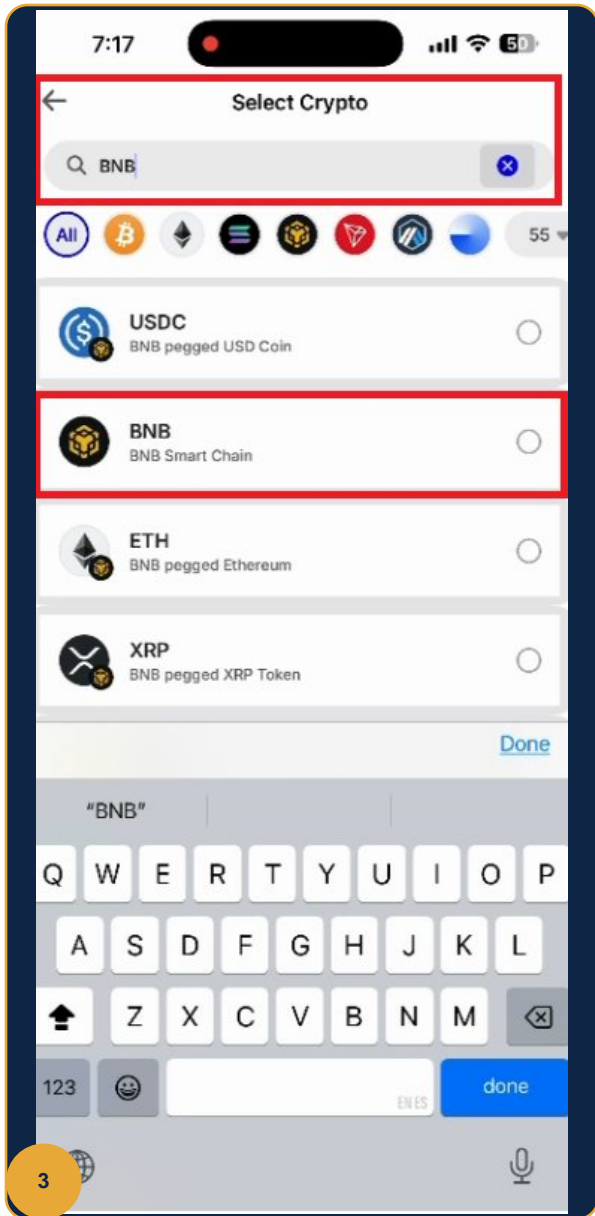


STEP 2 OF 6

Choose your payment method

Select your preferred payment method. Apple Pay is shown as recommended. You can also tap All payment methods to see additional options including credit/debit card and P2P.

Tip: Payment options vary by country. Apple Pay is the fastest option if available to you.

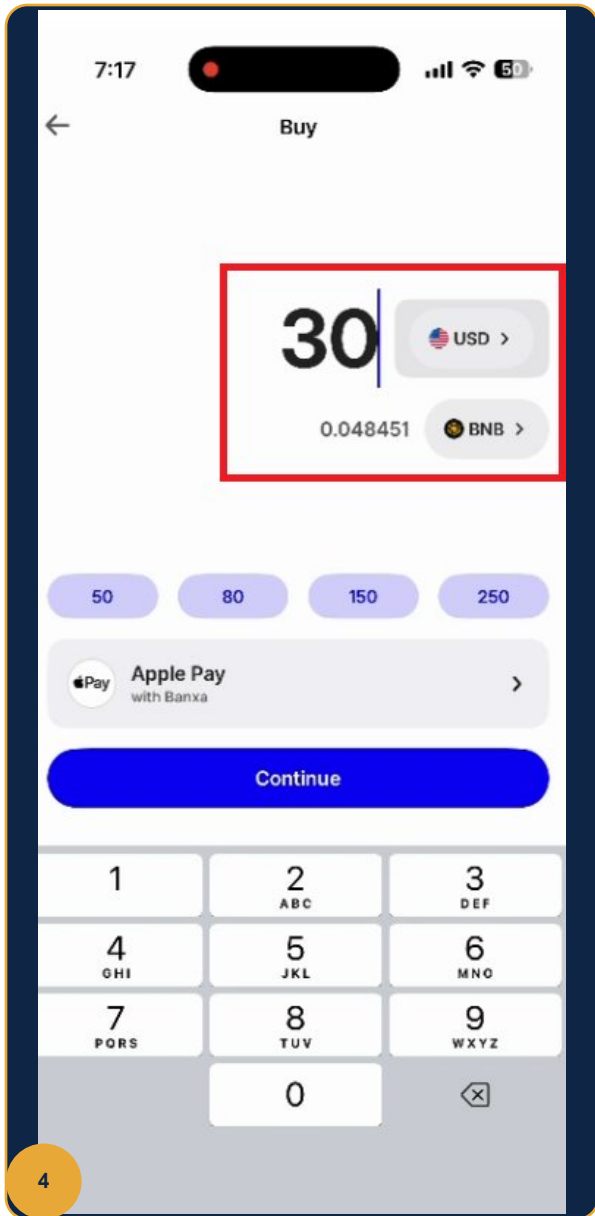


STEP 3 OF 6

Search for and select BNB

On the Select Crypto screen, type BNB in the search bar, then tap BNB / BNB Smart Chain from the results.

Tip: Make sure you select BNB Smart Chain specifically — not BNB Beacon Chain.

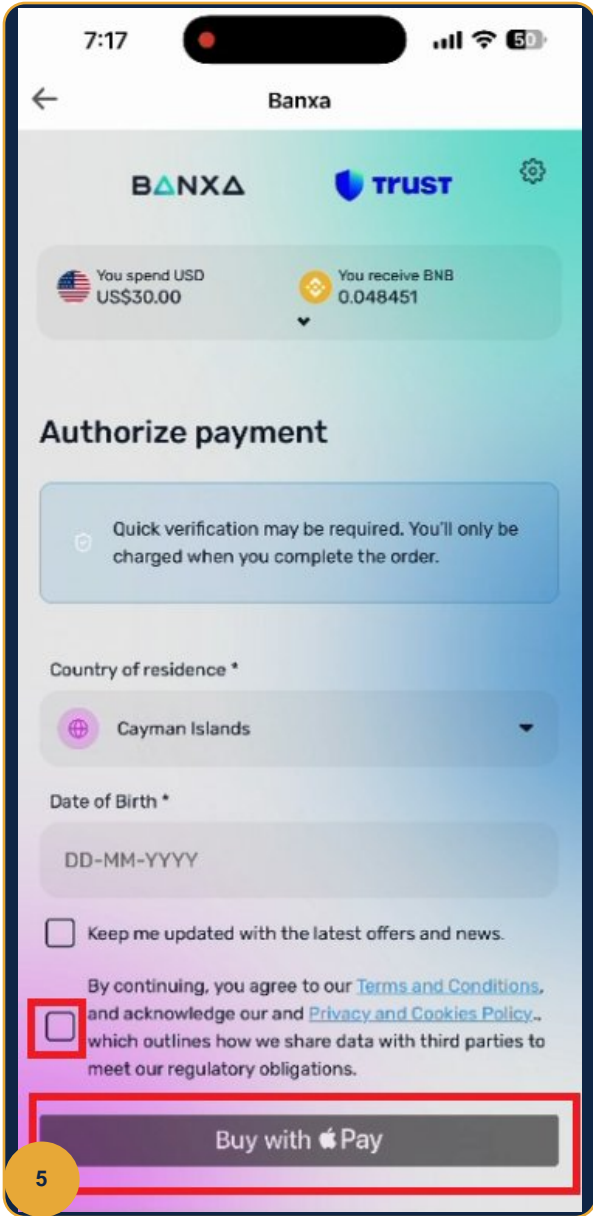


STEP 4 OF 6

Enter the amount you want to spend

Type in the USD amount you want to spend. You will see the equivalent BNB amount update in real time. Use the quick-select buttons or type a custom amount. Tap Continue when ready.

Tip: Only buy as much BNB as you intend to swap for MUFU. Keep a small amount for network fees.

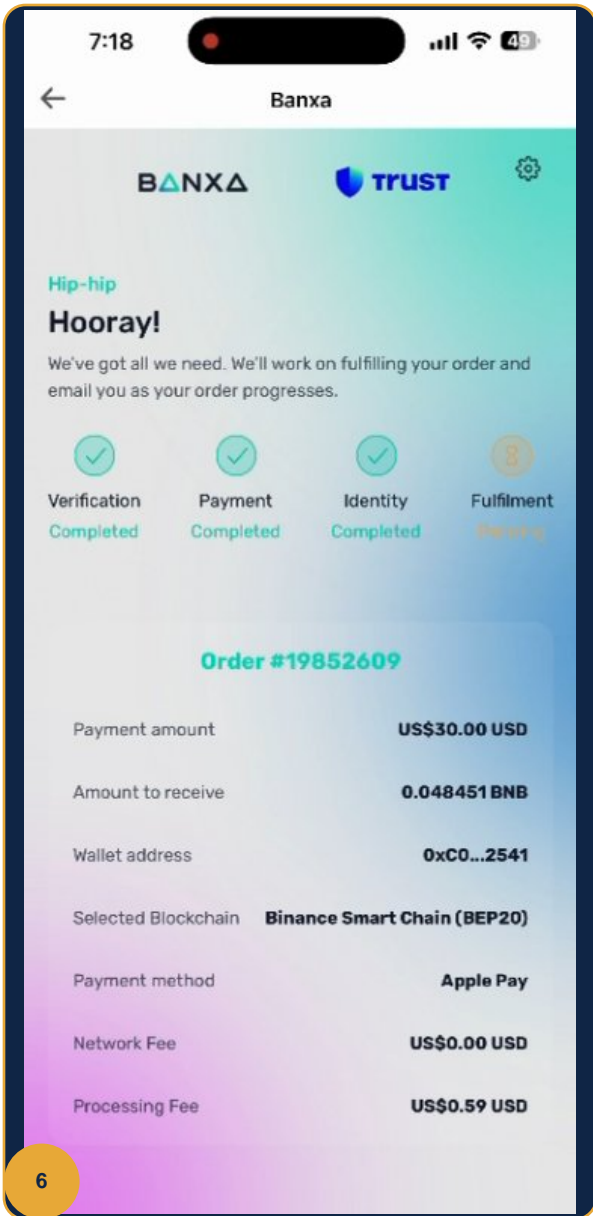


STEP 5 OF 6

Enter your details and authorize

Fill in the details requested on screen — this may include your country of residence and date of birth. Accept the terms and conditions, then tap the button to complete your purchase.

Note: Quick identity verification may be required for first-time purchases. You will only be charged once the order is fully confirmed.



STEP 6 OF 6

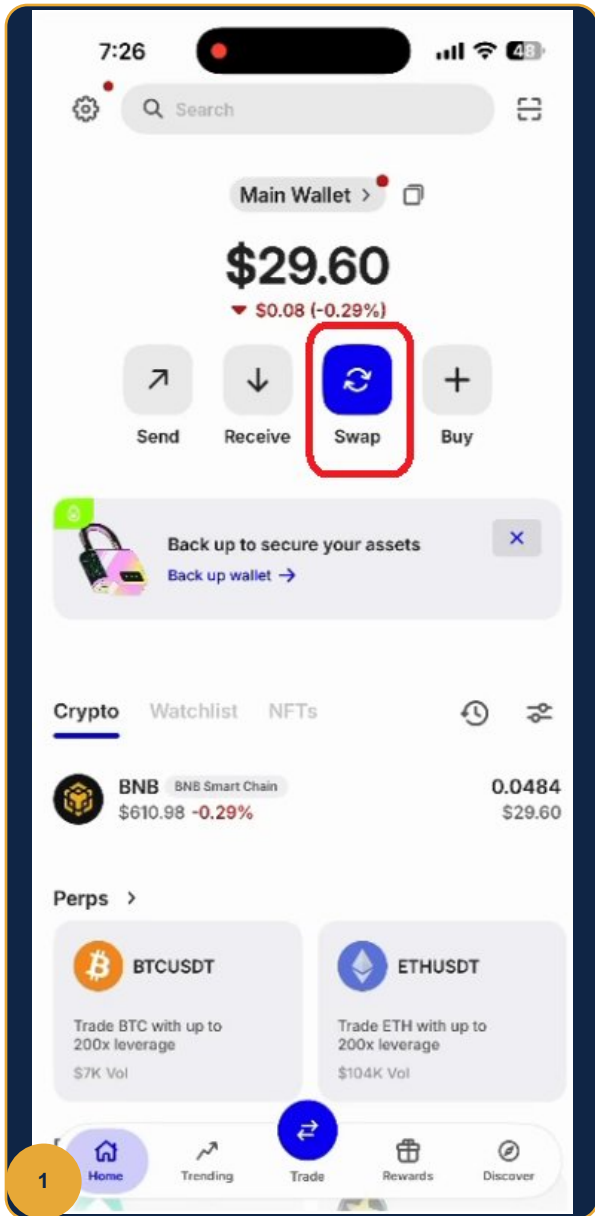
Order confirmed — BNB on its way!

Your order confirmation screen shows it is being processed. Verification, Payment, and Identity are all completed. Your BNB will be delivered to your Trust Wallet once fulfilment is complete.

Tip: You will receive an email confirmation as your order progresses. BNB typically arrives within a few minutes.

iPHONE — 3. Swap BNB for MUFU

Follow these 2 steps to swap BNB for MUFU. The swap unlocks at 16:11 UTC on March 31, 2026.

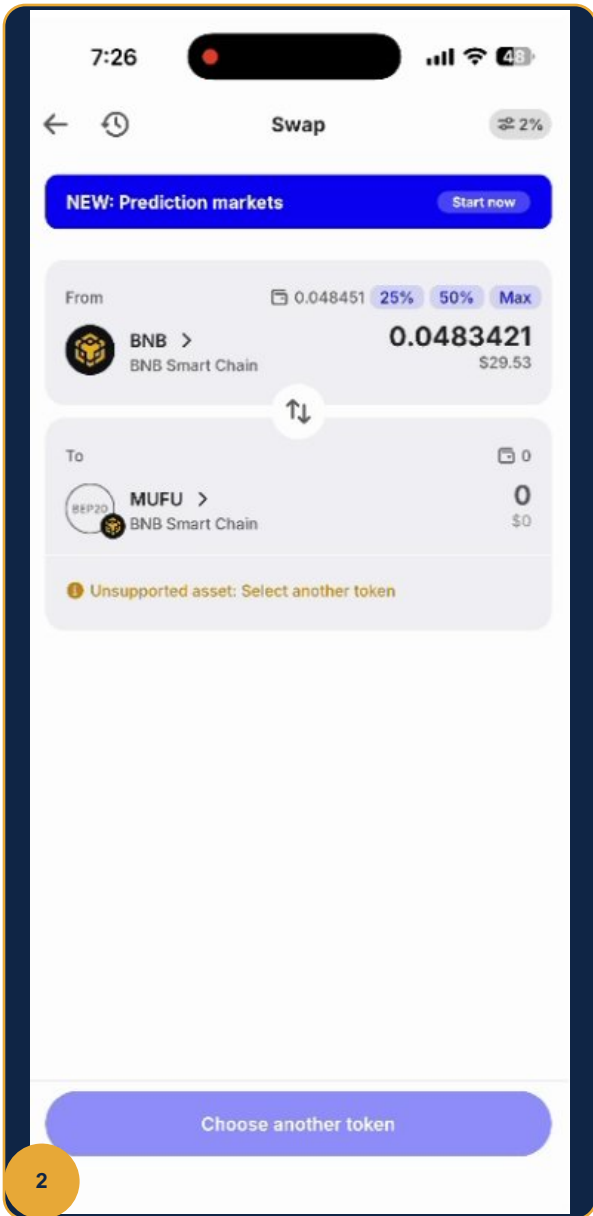


STEP 1 OF 2

Open Trust Wallet and tap Swap

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Swap button — the circular arrows icon — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure you have BNB in your wallet before attempting the swap. You will need a small amount of BNB left over for network fees.



STEP 2 OF 2

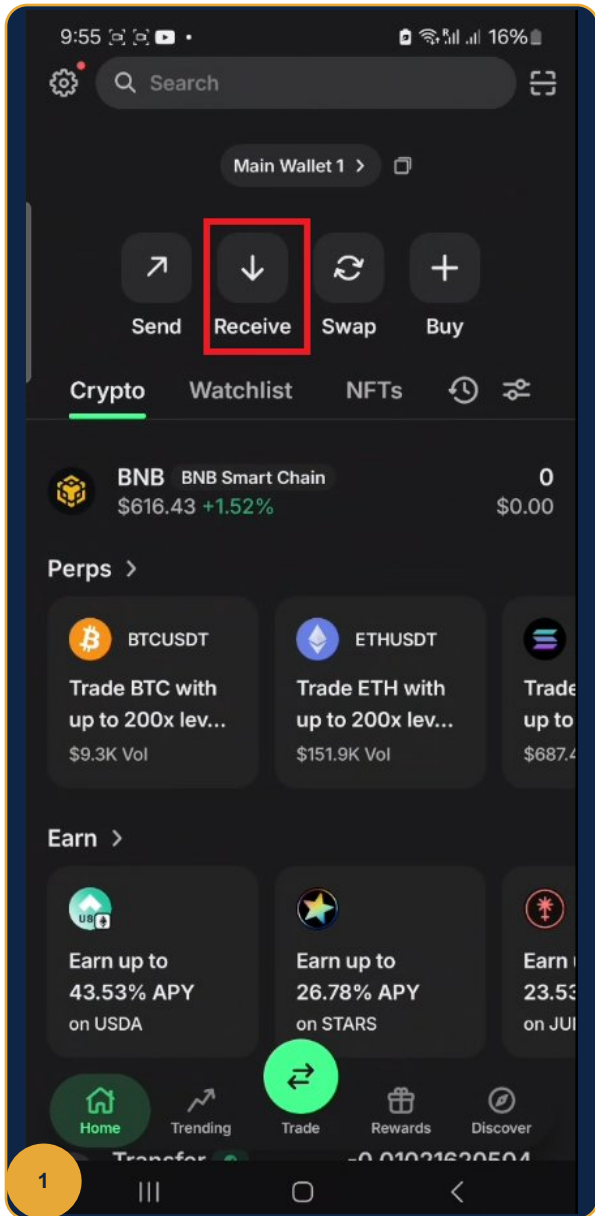
Set BNB as "From" and MUFU as "To"

The swap screen shows BNB as the "From" token. For the "To" token, select MUFU from your Recently used list — do not search for it manually, as scammers create fake tokens with similar names. Only the MUFU in your Recently used list is the verified token you imported.

Note: The swap will only work after the token goes live at 16:11 UTC on March 31, 2026. If you see an error before that time, please wait until after launch.

ANDROID — 1. Add MUFU to Wallet

Follow these 8 steps to add MUFU to Trust Wallet on your Android device. Contract address:
0xAACDd8EA3F1893d01f9DA413C0a593fb39B970B9

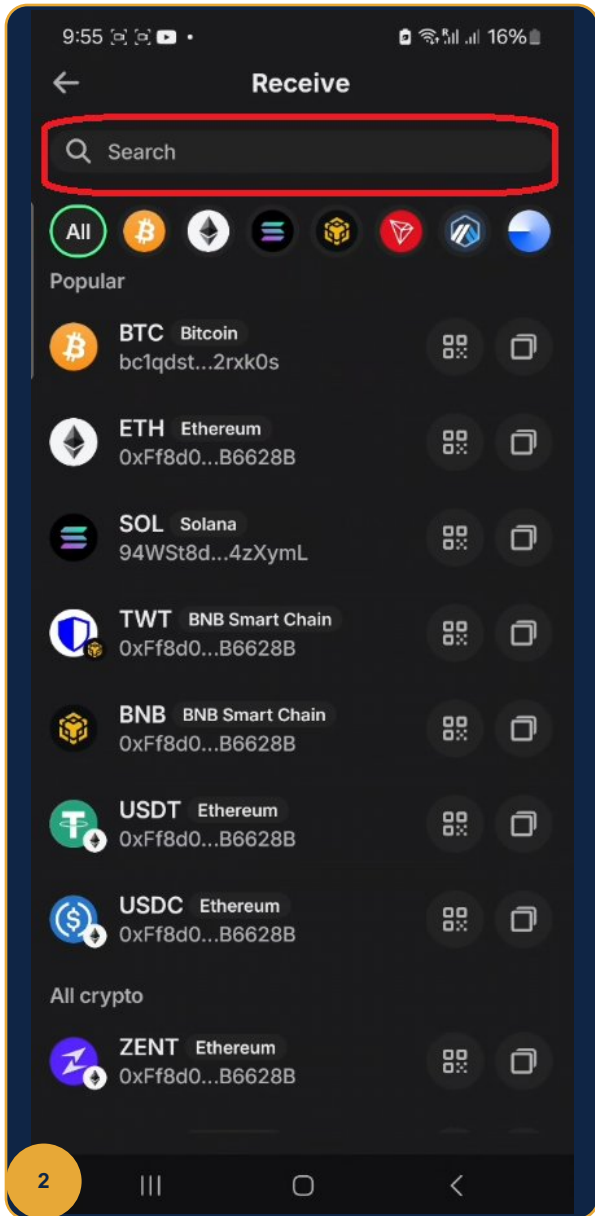


STEP 1 OF 8

Open Trust Wallet and tap Receive

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Receive button — the downward arrow — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure Trust Wallet is installed from the Google Play Store.



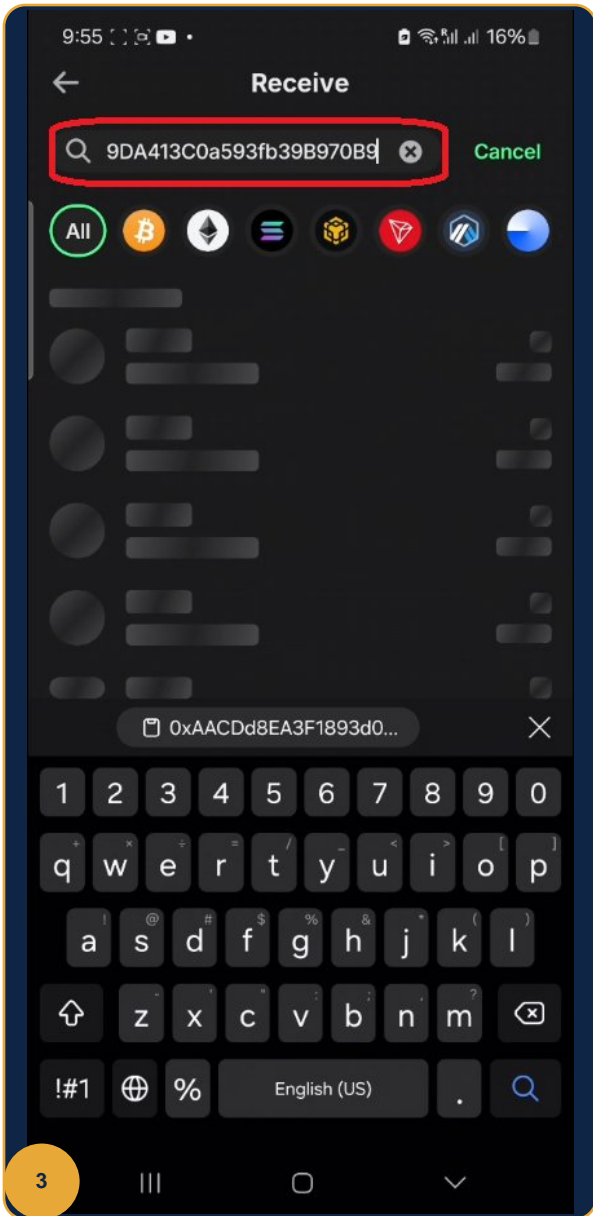
STEP 2 OF 8

Copy the CA, then tap the Search bar

Copy the MUFU contract address:

0xAACDd8EA3F1893d01f9DA413C0a593fb39B970B9 — then tap the Search bar at the top of the Receive screen.

Tip: Do not scroll looking for MUFU — it must be imported manually as it is newly launched.

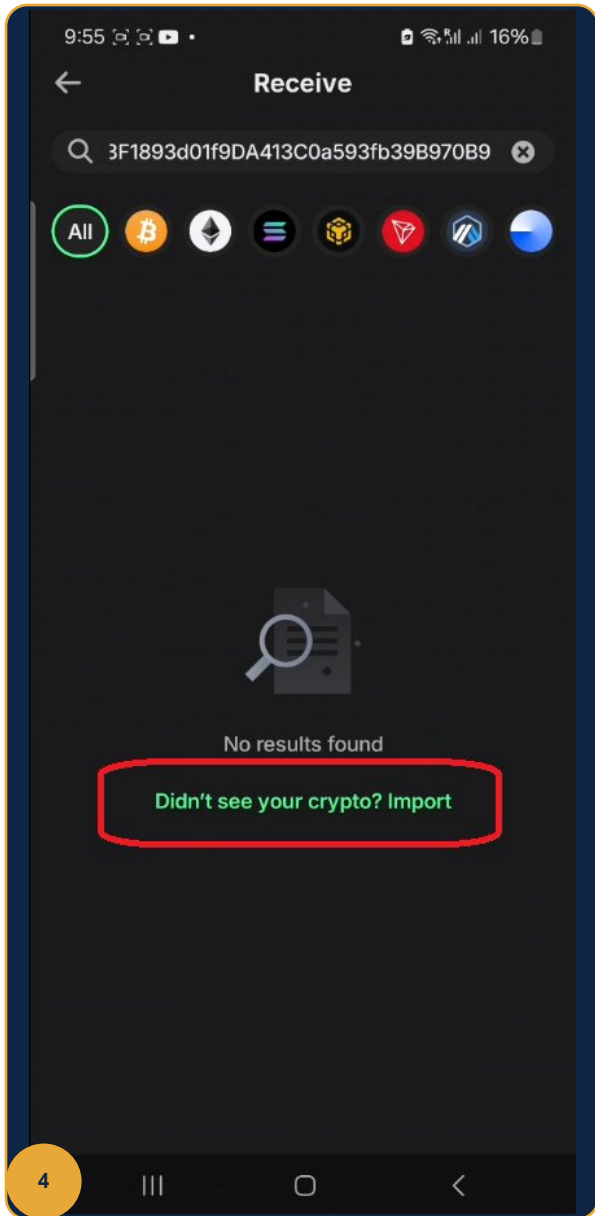


STEP 3 OF 8

Paste the contract address

Paste the full contract address into the search bar. Android may show a clipboard suggestion above the keyboard — tap it to paste quickly.

Tip: Use the clipboard suggestion bar if it appears — it pastes the full address in one tap.

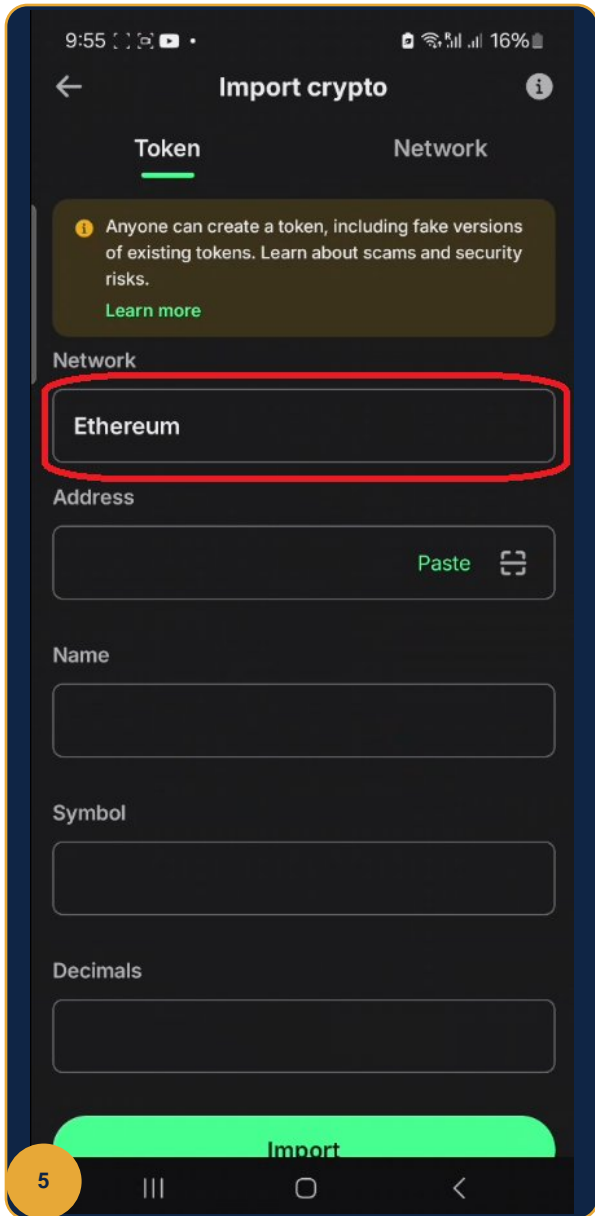


STEP 4 OF 8

Tap "Didn't see your crypto? Import"

The search will return no results. Tap the green Import link at the bottom to open the Import crypto screen.

Tip: This link only appears after a search with no results — make sure the full contract address is in the search bar first.

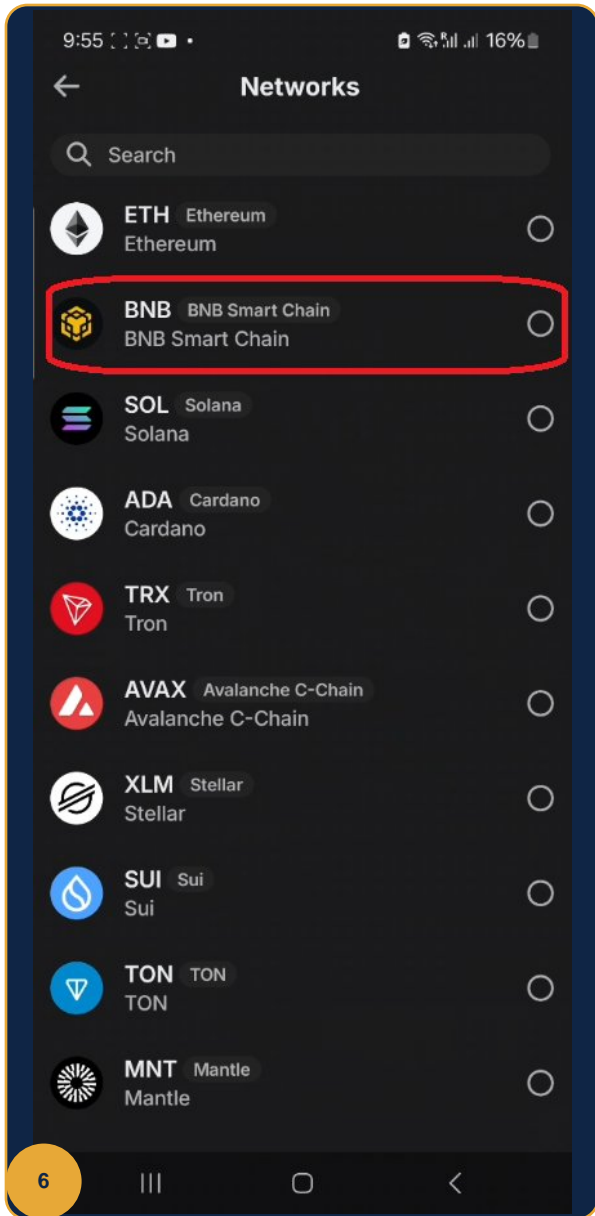


STEP 5 OF 8

Change the network to BNB Smart Chain

The Import crypto screen opens with Ethereum pre-selected. Tap the Network field to change it before entering the contract address.

Note: Critical: selecting Ethereum instead of BNB Smart Chain will cause the import to fail.

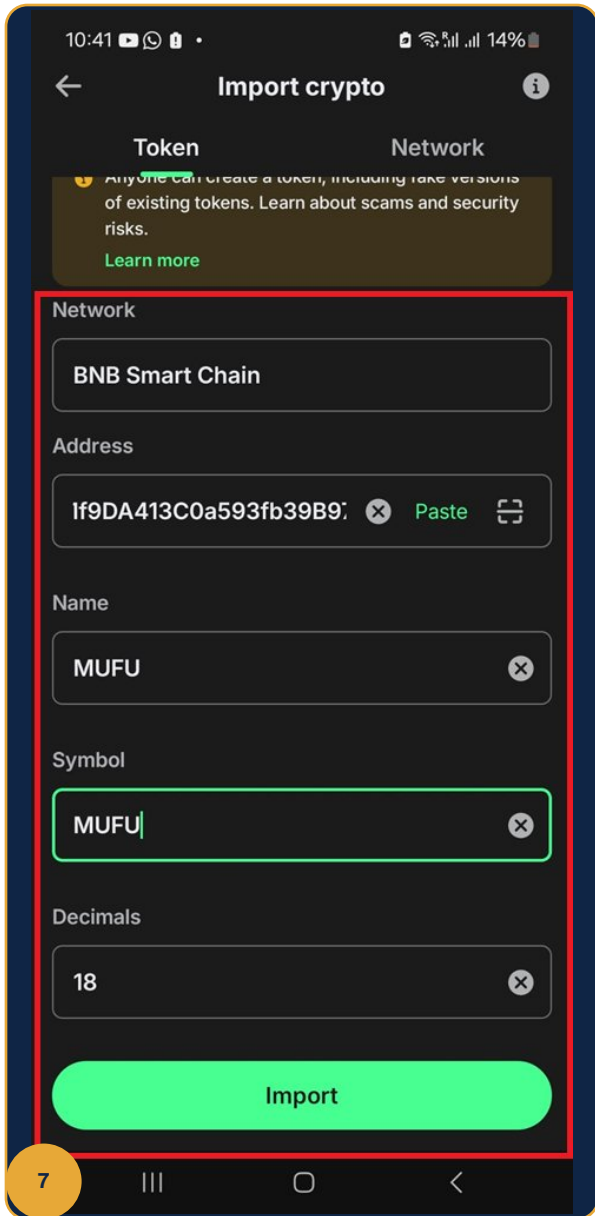


STEP 6 OF 8

Select BNB Smart Chain from the list

On the Networks screen, tap BNB Smart Chain (shown as BNB). Use the search bar at the top if needed.

Tip: Android shows ticker symbols (BNB, ETH, SOL) alongside network names — look for BNB / BNB Smart Chain.

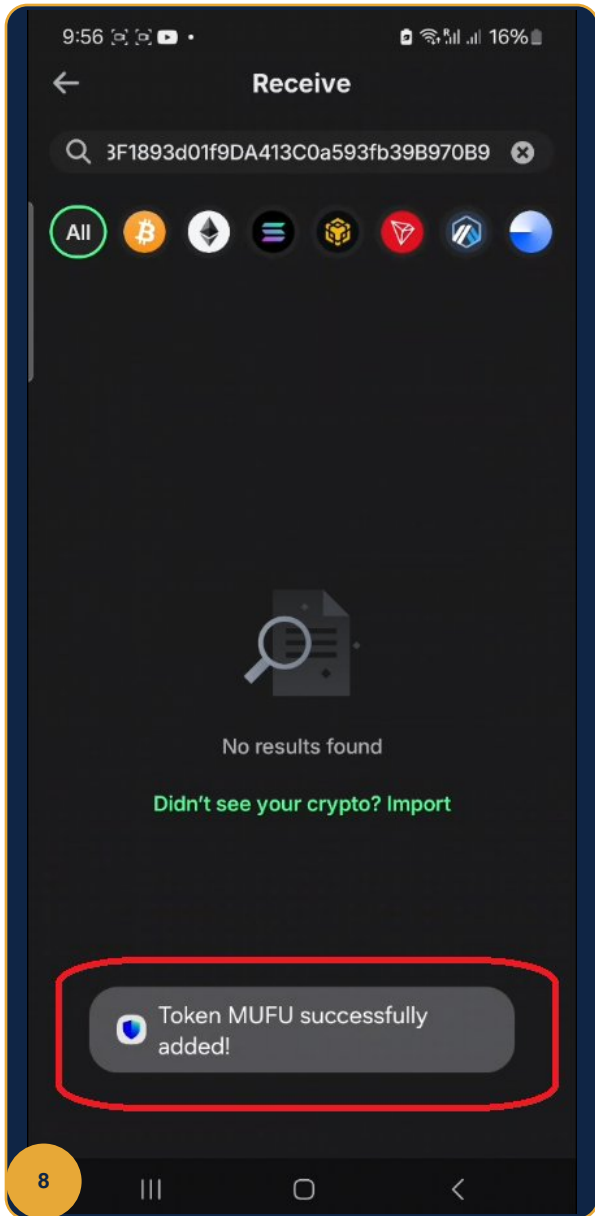


STEP 7 OF 8

Confirm token details and tap Import

On Android, the fields typically auto-fill: Name = MUFU, Symbol = MUFU, Decimals = 18. Verify all three, then tap the green Import button.

Note: If any field does not auto-fill, enter it manually. Decimals must be 18.



STEP 8 OF 8

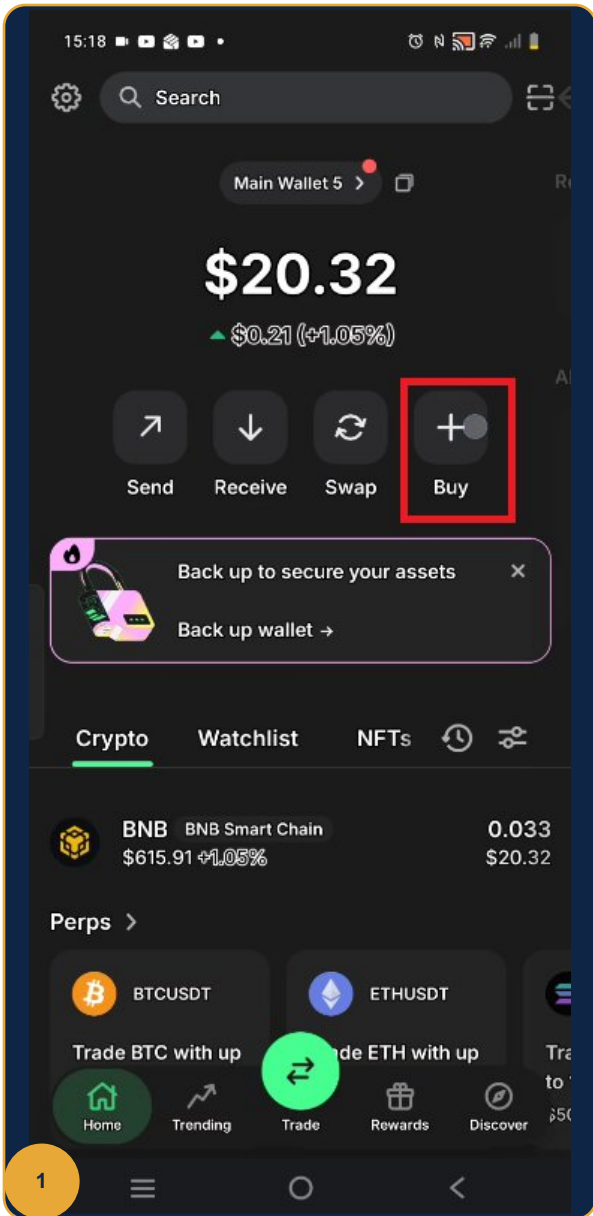
MUFU successfully added!

A confirmation toast appears: "Token MUFU successfully added!" You can now search for MUFU in the Receive screen and tap it to get your receive address and QR code.

Note: Only send MUFU (BEP-20) to your wallet address. Sending any other token type will result in permanent loss of funds.

ANDROID — 2. Buy BNB

Follow these 5 steps to purchase BNB in Trust Wallet on your Android device.

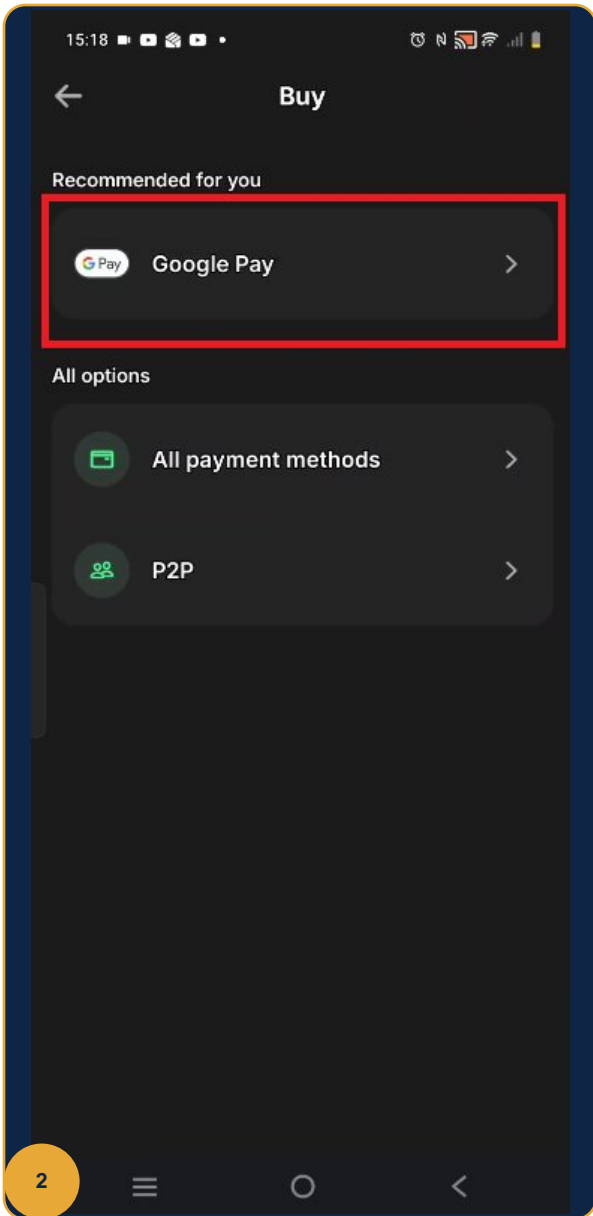


STEP 1 OF 5

Open Trust Wallet and tap Buy

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Buy button — the + icon — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure Trust Wallet is installed from the Google Play Store and your wallet is set up.

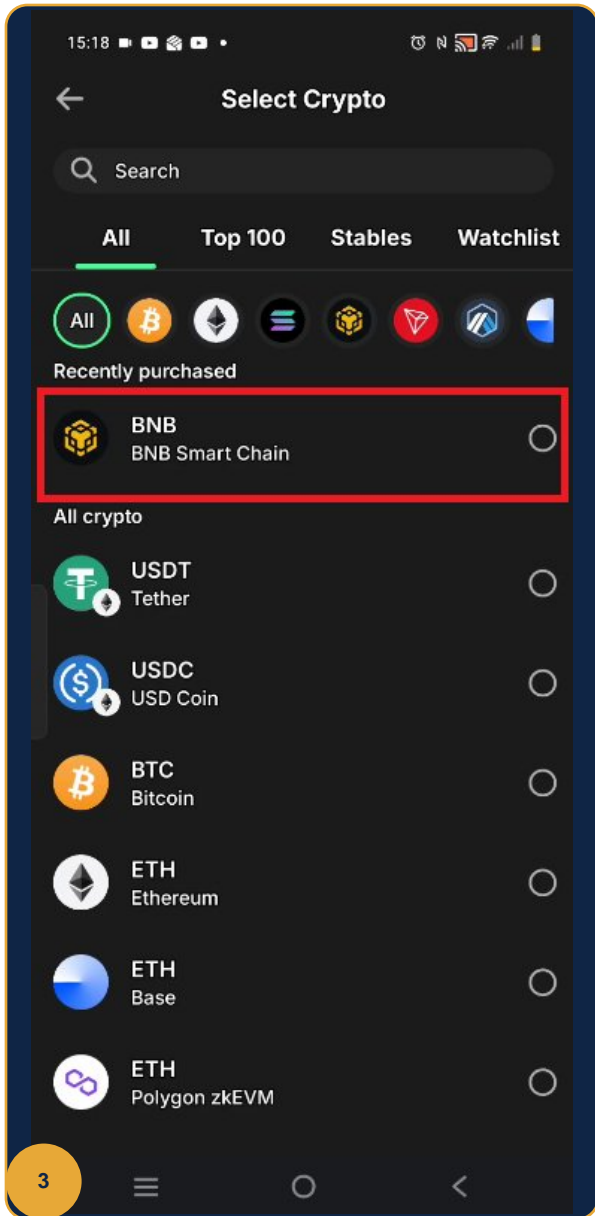


STEP 2 OF 5

Choose your payment method

Select your preferred payment method. Google Pay is shown as recommended. You can also tap All payment methods to see additional options including credit/debit card, bank transfer, and P2P.

Tip: Payment options vary by country. Google Pay is the fastest option if available to you.

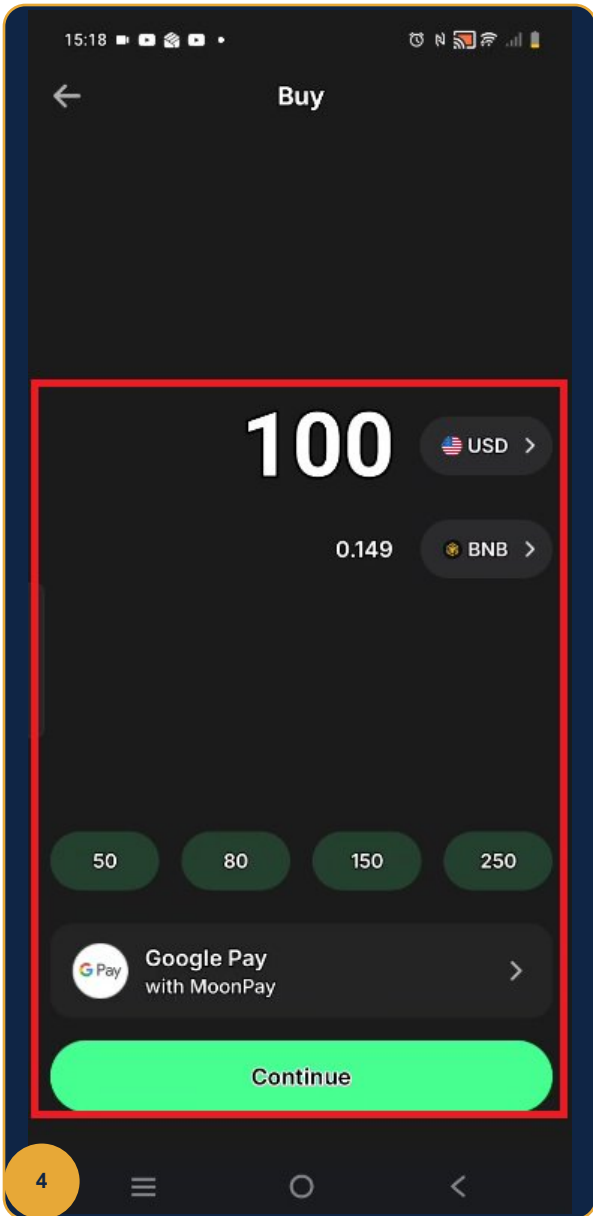


STEP 3 OF 5

Select BNB on BNB Smart Chain

On the Select Crypto screen, tap BNB / BNB Smart Chain. It will appear under "Recently purchased" if you have bought it before, otherwise find it in the All crypto list.

Tip: Make sure you select BNB Smart Chain specifically — not BNB Beacon Chain.

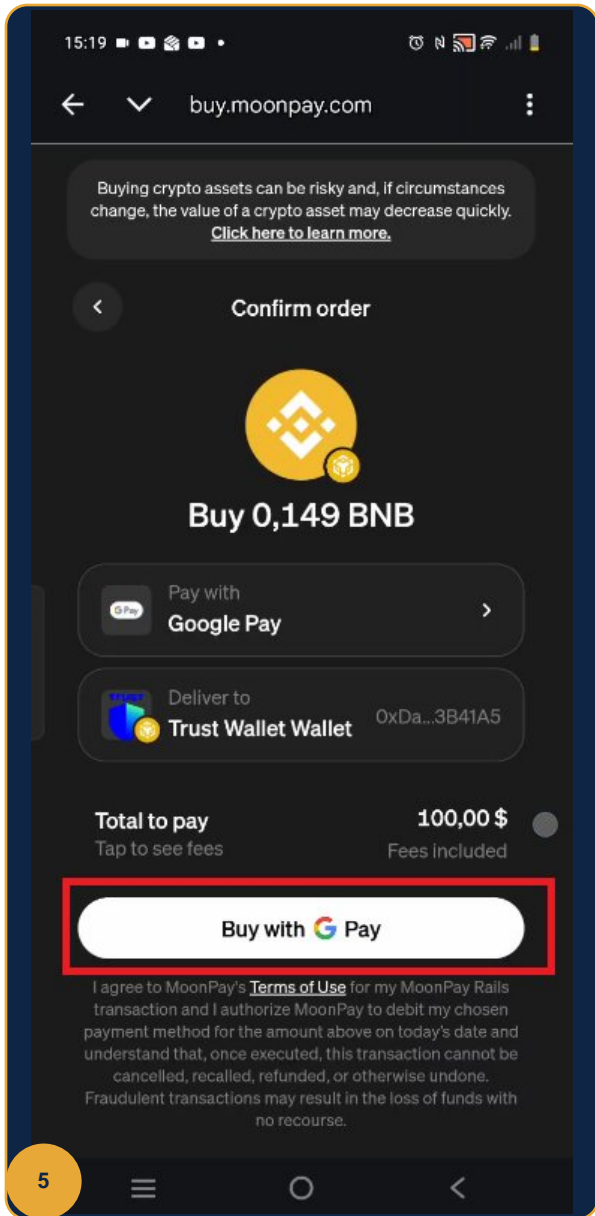


STEP 4 OF 5

Enter the amount you want to spend

Type in the USD amount you want to spend. You will see the equivalent BNB amount update in real time. Use the quick-select buttons (50, 80, 150, 250) or enter a custom amount. Tap Continue when ready.

Tip: Only buy as much BNB as you intend to swap for MUFU. Keep a small amount for network fees.



STEP 5 OF 5

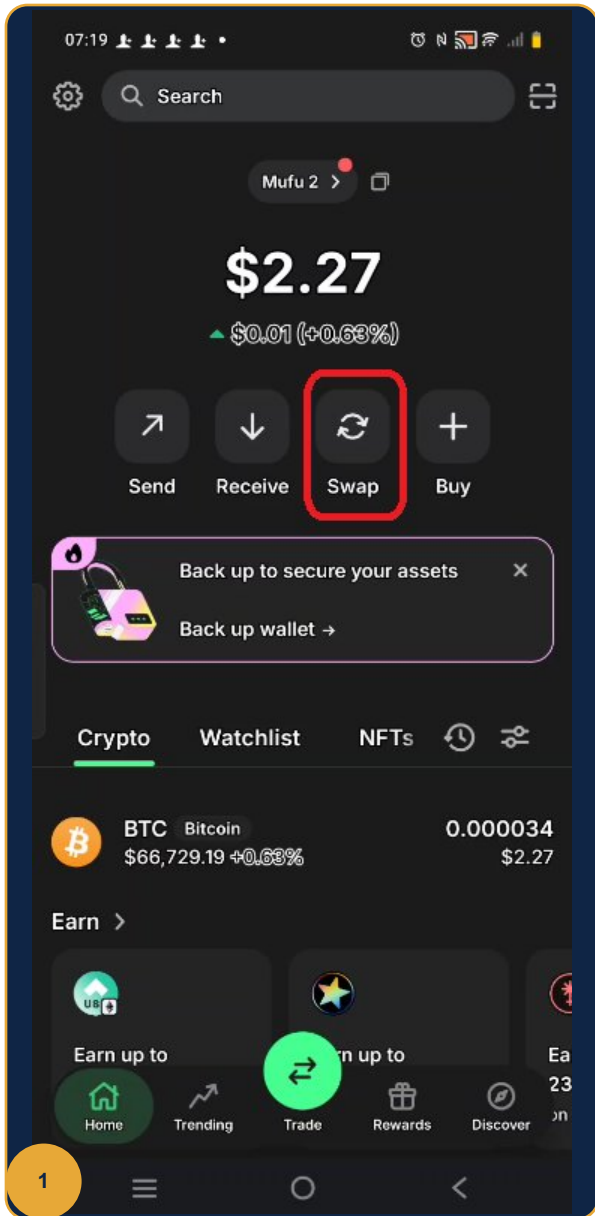
Review and confirm your order

Check the order summary: the BNB amount, payment method, delivery wallet, and total to pay. When satisfied, tap Buy with Google Pay (or your chosen payment method) to complete the purchase.

Note: Once confirmed this transaction cannot be cancelled. Double-check the amount and wallet address before tapping Buy.

ANDROID — 3. Swap BNB for MUFU

Follow these 3 steps to swap BNB for MUFU. The swap unlocks at 16:11 UTC on March 31, 2026.

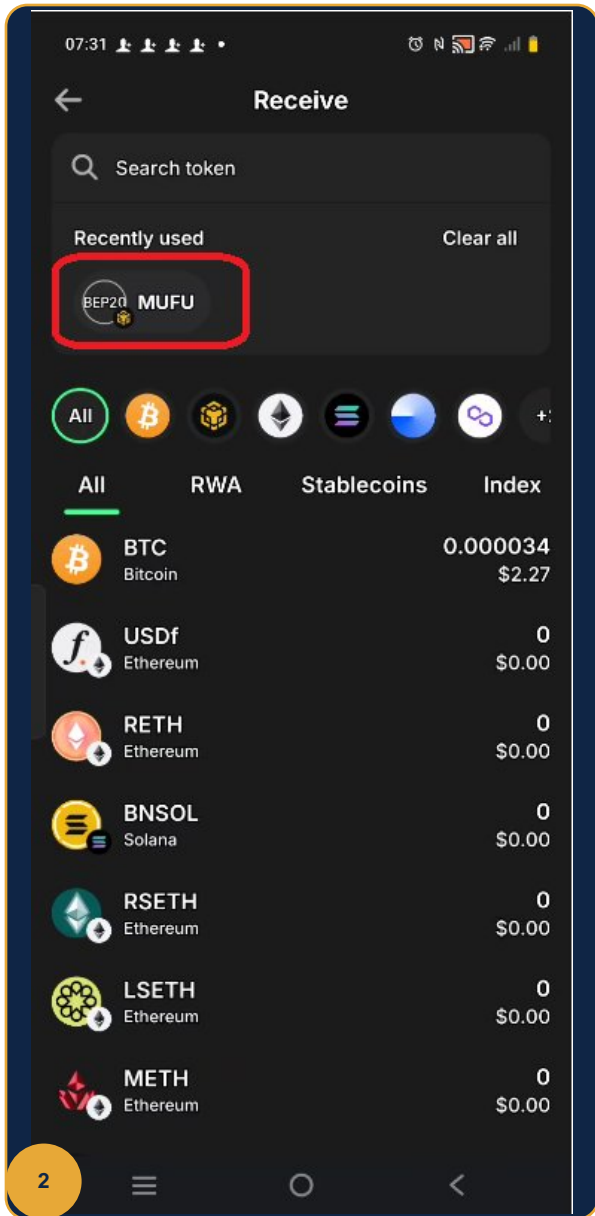


STEP 1 OF 3

Open Trust Wallet and tap Swap

On the Trust Wallet home screen, tap the Swap button — the circular arrows icon — in the action row below your balance.

Tip: Make sure you have BNB in your wallet before attempting the swap. You will need a small amount of BNB left over for network fees.

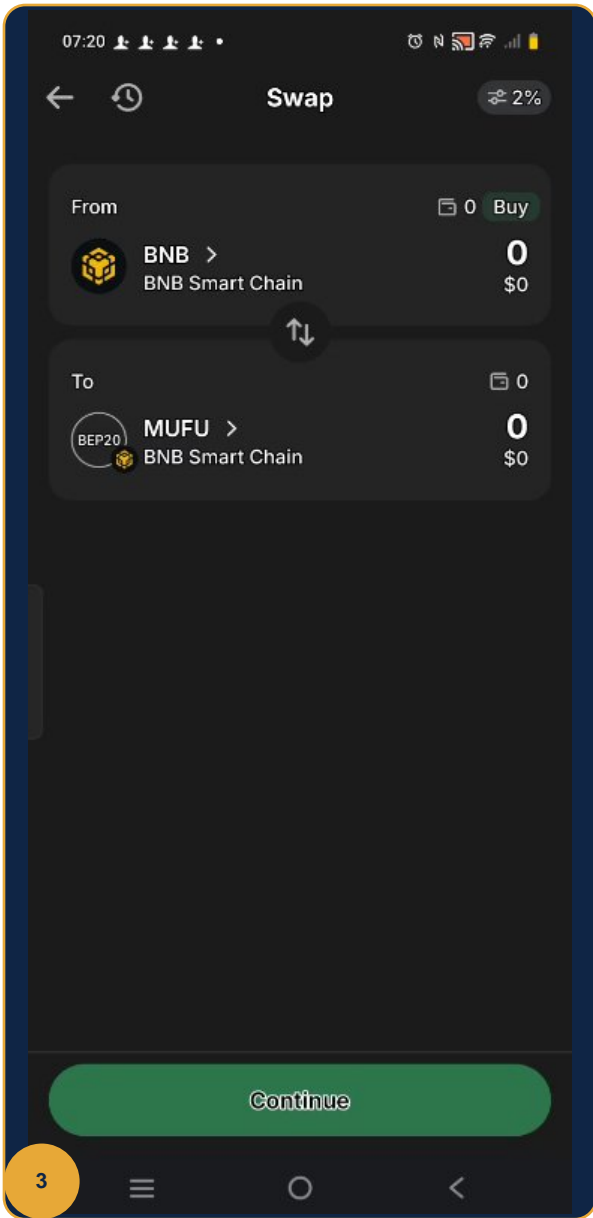


STEP 2 OF 3

Select MUFU from your Recently used list

On the token selection screen, you will see a Recently used section at the top. Tap MUFU from that list — do not search for it by name, as scammers create fake tokens with similar names. Only the MUFU in your Recently used list is the verified token you imported.

Note: Never select a token by searching the name "MUFU". Always select from the Recently used list to ensure you are swapping the correct verified token.



STEP 3 OF 3

Review the swap and tap Continue

The swap screen shows BNB as the "From" token and MUFU as the "To" token on BNB Smart Chain. Enter the amount of BNB you want to swap, review the details, then tap Continue.

Note: The swap will only work after the token goes live at 16:11 UTC on March 31, 2026. If you see an error before that time, please wait until after launch.

Important Reminders

Only send MUFU (BEP-20) to your wallet address.	Sending ERC-20, TRC-20, or any other standard will result in permanent loss of funds.
Always verify the contract address.	0xAACDd8EA3F1893d01f9DA413C0a593fb39B970B9 — copy it from mufutoken.com only.
Network must be BNB Smart Chain.	MUFU will not function on Ethereum or any other network.
Decimals must be 18.	If entering token details manually, ensure Decimals is set to 18.
Never select MUFU by searching the name.	Always use the Recently used list when swapping to avoid fake tokens.
Swap is only available after launch.	The swap feature unlocks at 16:11 UTC on March 31, 2026.
